

Cooperstown City Council
Special Meeting
September 22, 2020 – City Hall – 7:45 AM

President Perry called the meeting to order at 7:45 am. Members present included Steve Perry, Deb Eslinger, Tim Erickson, Lee Watne & Larry Olson. Absent: Paul Paintner & Allen Gruman. Others in attendance: Blaine Larson, Nancy Lunde

Plow Truck/plow: Tim Erickson reported on the trucks he inspected in Bismarck that are being offered on the State-Fleet Auction. After discussion Olson moved, Eslinger seconded, to approve a maximum bid of \$25,000 on a 2005 Mack CV713 TA Dump & Spread truck offered on the State-Fleet Auction, ending 9-23-20. Motion carried unanimously. Erickson moved, Eslinger seconded, to authorize Christine Olson to manage the bidding process for this auction for the City of Cooperstown. Motion carried unanimously.

Cooper Drain #3: There was discussion of the condition of Cooper Drain #3 and the need for mowing and maintenance in the drain. The consensus is that the City needs to do what is necessary to get the drain working properly and draining as it should. Olson moved, Erickson seconded, to approve an estimate from Tafelmeyer Seed Sales & Custom Service for mowing within Cooper Drain #3. Motion carried unanimously.

Erickson moved, Eslinger seconded, to adjourn the meeting.
