

Cooperstown City Council  
Special Meeting  
September 18, 2018 – City Hall – 7:30 AM

Mayor Paintner called the meeting to order at 7:30 am. Members present included Paul Paintner, Nic Zimprich, Deb Eslinger, Lee Watne, Rick Cushman, Tim Erickson & Larry Olson. Others in attendance: Blaine Larson & Nancy Lunde.

**Railroad Survey:** There was discussion of the railroad property survey done by Moore Engineering. Andrew Aakre met with Blaine Larson and Rick Cushman previously to discuss what other areas the city council would want staked and if the area west of the railroad property could also be surveyed for an additional \$2000.00. Eslinger moved, Watne seconded to approve the additional survey of property west of the railroad property and additional stakes to be added along the railroad property by Moore Engineering for an additional \$2000.00. Motion carried unanimously.

**Abraham Generator Sales:** Blaine Larson gave the council information regarding the water and sewer located west of Abraham Generator Sales. He stated he had received a quote of \$5500.00 from Ellefson Sales & Excavating to extend the 6-inch sewer and water lines from the existing lines on the south side of the highway toward Abraham Generator Sales. Extending the lines would help with the slope of the lines in the area. There would be a curb stop and 2 manholes installed also. Cushman moved, Erickson seconded, to approve an extension of 6-inch sewer and water lines from the existing lines on the south side of the highway towards Abraham Generator Sales to help with the slope of lines in the area, and with an added curb-stop and 2 manholes. Motion carried unanimously.

**Office Printer/Copier:** The council compared the specifications of 3 different printer/copiers. After discussion, Erickson moved, Cushman seconded, to table further discussion of replacing the city hall printer/copier. Motion carried unanimously.

Cushman moved, Zimprich seconded, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 am.
