Special Meeting

June 17, 2021

The Cooperstown City Council met Wednesday, June 17, 2021, at 7:00 pm in the city council room. Present: Paul Paintner, Steve Perry, Deb Eslinger, Larry Olson, and Allen Gruman. Sheyenne Tooling approached the city about paving 9th St from Posi Lock building to the south Sheyenne Tooling building. A quote of \$85,800.00 was received from Bituminous Paving for this work. Council will contact other businesses in the area to see if they anticipate wanting Sunflower Ave paved. The city will research the option of a special assessment district for the businesses should they want to move forward.

The option of paving 1st and 16th Streets was discussed. Council will talk with the county commission about a possible cost share to pave 16th Street next year.

Chris Coombs has approached the city about purchasing the city owned building at 604 10th St NE. Motion by Gruman to not sell the property at this time, seconded by Erickson. Motion carried.

Motion by Perry to approve the special event permit for Di's Oasis bar to operate a beer gardens on July 7, seconded by Gruman. Motion carried.

Motion by Eslinger to approve the CMC Foundation Local permit for a raffle to be held on July 10, seconded by L. Olson. Motion carried.

Motion by Erickson to approve the Cooperstown Community Club permit for a street dance to be held on July 10, seconded by Gruman. Motion carried.
