

ORDINANCE 2007-2  
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF GOLF CARTS WITHIN THE CITY OF  
COOPERSTOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
COOPERSTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA:

Introduction

Whereas, the laws of the State of North Dakota and the Home Rule Charter of the City of Cooperstown allow the City to provide for the operation of golf carts on City streets; so now therefore:

Section 1. Golf Carts on City Streets

Golf carts may be operated on city streets in the City of Cooperstown only under the following conditions and subject to the following restrictions: 1) Golf carts may be operated only by persons with valid driver's licenses during daytime travel between the owner's place of residence and the golf course, taking the most direct route available and without stopping at business locations within the City.; 2) Golf cart operators must obey and are subject to all state and local traffic laws that motor vehicles are subject to; 3) Golf carts may not be operated on federal, state or county highways, except for the perpendicular crossing of these highways; 4) Notwithstanding restriction No. 1, person's operating golf carts pursuant to this Ordinance may not operate golf carts within the downtown business district of the City, and if the most direct route from their place of residence to the golf course intersects downtown, then the next most direct route shall be used.

Section 2. Penalty. A violation of this ordinance shall be considered an infraction, punishable by a \$20 fine for a first offense and punishable by a \$20-\$100 fine for any subsequent offenses.

Section 3. Effective Date:

This ordinance is in force and takes effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
